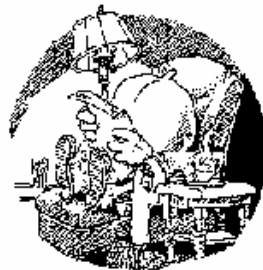

## GROWERS FINANCES

Growers has separate bank accounts for the food co-op and the Growers Market Building, so that we can track the different operations. Growers Market, Inc. (the food co-op plus the building) did well financially in 2005. At the end of the year, we could have transferred \$5,000 to our Calvert savings account, but we will probably be spending that money to replace plumbing under the building. The co-op seemed to lose money in the early part of 2005, but ended up making \$13,053, partly because the year-end inventory was \$6,387 higher than the previous year. Nonetheless, Growers finances are tight; we have not yet recovered from the financial crisis that happened when the space we currently rent to Red Agave stood empty for a number of months.
