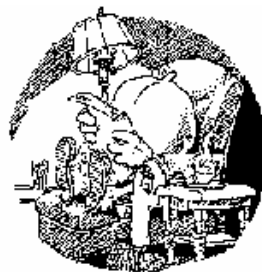

Turn right (west) onto Main Street. After passing through downtown, the Main St. becomes CG-Lorane Road. Just before mile marker 5, turn right onto Hazelton Rd. Avalon Stables is about 1/4 mile up the road on the right at 80143 Hazelton Rd. *See you there!*
