

She has been involved with the Fruit Booth for the Oregon Country Fair, and was on the BOD. Years ago when the DUMA housing coop started, she was in the group who started the talks. She currently works at The Pearl Buck Center for people with developmental diseases getting them into the work force

Why Growers? For the community and she definitely wants to support its grassroots way of working. She also shops elsewhere but gets the bulk of her produce and bulk foods here. Over the years she's been on and off depending on the fullness of her schedule. Her job is Orientation on Fridays which she initiated as a new job and is happy to say that there are a couple newbies to orient each time. She likes making Growers more accessible and helping people find a place at Growers.

Leauriy likes that Growers is "funky". She loves the new re-vamped floor, and the little things that are ever changing and improving with the community's input. It's low key. It's under the wire.

Leauriy says, "When I give my orientations, I say, I know there are people who eat meat, but here, we're honoring the vegetarians, giving them more comfort shopping here."

The challenge, she says, is to keep people coming in and putting in shifts. Her favorite treat at Growers is the Kelp Sesame snacks. She's gotta learn to make them because they are like an obsession for her! She also likes the coco products--almost every part of the coconut is here.
