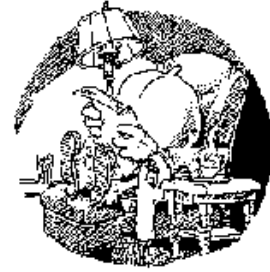

SHOP EARLY FOR A FULL SELECTION:

Camas Country Mill: black turtle beans, pinto beans, orca beans, lentils (brown, cedar, crimson), garbanzos, oat groats, Scottish oats, flax seed, golden hullless barley, white hullless barley, whole grains and flours, Club Wheat pastry flour, spelt flour, plus winter storage boxes

Diamond Hill Farm: garlic, winter squash (Blue Hokaido and Sugar Loaf), Painted Mountain shelled corn and corn flour, dry beans (French Horticulture)

Honey Tree Apiaries: raw honey

Honor Earth Farm: hazelnuts (in shell)

Lively Organic Farm: Wintersquash (mixed cases of Butternut/Delicata)

Lonesome Whistle Farm: garlic and garlic braids, Abenaki Flint Corn, polenta, corn flour, Dakota Black Popcorn, purple hullless barley, buckwheat grouts, Dark Northern rye flour, wheat berries and flours (hard red, soft white, red fife), heirloom dry beans

Organic Redneck McKenzie River Farm: carrots, beets, frozen and dried blueberries

Open Oak Farm: garlic and garlic braids, winter squash (Sweet Meat), buckwheat flour, corn meal, polenta, rye flour, heirloom bean mix, heirloom beans

Running Wild Rice: wild rice

SLO Farm: storage apples (Braeburn), Asian pears, applesauce, red and green cabbage, fingerling potatoes, winter squash (Sunshine)
