

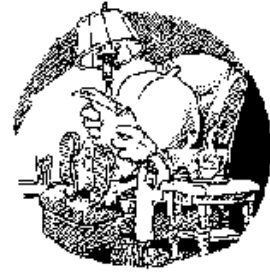

GROWERS MONEY

For the year 2013, the Growers Market building fund ended up plus \$3,146.31, the co-op was minus \$4,075.34 and the fruit booth finished at plus \$2,916.93. Growers Market, inc. as a whole was plus \$1,987.90. Growers Market, inc. money is actually in "one big pot." In other words, the different checking accounts are really accounting fictions.

The ten-year history for the co-op is as follows: for 2004: plus \$3,788; for 2005: plus \$6,095; for 2006: minus \$5,831; for 2007: minus \$4,775; for 2008: plus \$13,804; for 2009: plus \$6,964; for 2010: minus \$1,915; for 2011: plus \$10,280; for 2012: minus \$2,776; for 2013: minus \$4,075. The co-op's contribution to the general fund has increased from \$3,800 in 2004 to \$6,000 starting in 2011.

When Growers started renting to Belly Taqueria, we invested \$13,935 in the restaurant space. We did not treat \$5,300 of the total as an expense for 2013, instead planning to show part of this \$5,300 as expenses in future years to reduce our income tax. During 2013, Growers saved \$4,434 in water and electric bills because the restaurant was closed for a period, and also because we found out that Growers had been paying for the restaurant's electricity. In the future, we will be saving about \$200 per month on our EWEB bill because we will be paying for our own electricity, not the restaurant's electricity. --Milton
